Maintenance at the Oakhurst Knolls Wastewater Treatment Plant

Franklin County's Department of Sanitary Engineering is responsible for the operation and maintenance of four (4) wastewater treatment facilities in Franklin County. Today, the Commissioners authorized the purchase of filters for the Oakhurst Knolls plant which provides sanitary service to 107 households in the southwest portion of the County. The replacement of the filters is expected to occur December to February and will not affect service to sanitary customers. The cost to purchase and install the replacement filters which have a life of 20 years is \$257,500.
