BOIL ALERT ISSUED FOR NEARLY 200 HOMES IN SOUTHWEST FRANKLIN COUNTY

As a result of a water main break, the Franklin County Department of Sanitary Engineering has issued a precautionary boil alert for residents of the following streets on the county's southwest side:

- All homes on the north side of Sullivant Avenue between Inah and Redmond Avenue
- All homes on the following streets between Sullivant and Owen Avenue:
 - o Inah
 - o Postle
 - o Fernhill
 - o Evergreen Terrace
 - o Woodlawn
 - o Hiler
 - o Redmond

Water service has been restored; however, residents will be required to boil their water for the following 24 hours before using in food preparation or drinking. Another advisory will be provided when the alert has been lifted. The water is safe for showers or bathing.
